

WEEE for Consumers in the Republic of Ireland

In full compliance with the WEEE Regulations, we will happily take back Waste and Electronic Equipment and Batteries from members of the public where equivalent replacement goods have been purchased from our website. Environmental Management costs will be applied to the retail price of new electrical and electronic goods.

As we are based in the UK and are distance selling into the Republic of Ireland, it does not make environmental sense for us to recover WEEE back to the UK. Therefore the facility outlined below has been made available for use by our customers in the Republic of Ireland.

Take Back and disposal Instructions

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations (SI 335 of 2011) (WEEE) and Waste Batteries have been put in place to ensure that products are recycled using best available treatment, recovery and recycling techniques to ensure human health and high environmental protection. When you have finished with a WEEE product, please do not put in your domestic waste bin as it will not be recycled. Please use one of the following disposal options instead:

When you purchase a product you may hand the old equivalent product back to the retailer. They should accept it as a requirement under the WEEE Regulations (SI 335 of 2011). In our case, as we are a distance selling retailer, we have made the facility below available for our customers and will collect the WEEE within 30 days of delivery of the new product.

Or take the WEEE to your local Civic Amenity Site and deposit it in the dedicated WEEE and waste battery area.

All of the above options enable the product and the batteries to be treated in accordance with the WEEE Regulations (SI 335 of 2011).

Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) and waste batteries must never be placed in your waste disposal or recycling bins. WEEE is taken back free of charge at the address below on a one-for-one like-for-like basis. There is a bin for small batteries at the address below. Local authority civic amenity facilities also take back WEEE and waste batteries free of charge. WEEE and waste battery recycling is free.

How to Return Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) and batteries

You may request collection from the service provider below within 30 days of delivery of your electronic and electrical equipment or you can return the WEEE and waste batteries to the following facility. WEEE for Business Customers in the Republic of Ireland

Irish Waste Management (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) Regulations 2005 ("the WEEE Regulations")

Business Customers buying from our website hereby agree to take on the legal obligation as "Producer" and for the recovery and disposal of EEE in accordance with the WEEE Regulations both on purchase and when the EEE reaches its end of life.

Article 13 of the WEEE Regulations, SI 340 of 2005, provides for distance selling and registration of same. As we do not have an established presence in the State, our Business Customers are therefore deemed to be the "Producer" of EEE. It shall be your responsibility, as direct importers of the EEE to the State, to register with the WEEE Register as a "Producer" of EEE.

The Business Customer and Buy it Direct acknowledge that for the purposes of Article 18 of the WEEE Regulations this paragraph shall be an agreement stipulating other financial arrangements for the environmentally sound management of WEEE.

The Business Customer acknowledges: (a) that it will register with the WEEE Register at its sole cost and relieve Buy it Direct of all responsibilities due to improper disposal of the waste product; (b) Buy it Direct shall upon written request from the Business Customer and without cost or charge to the Business Customer provide all information and data on any dangerous substance or preparation or hazardous substance contained in the sold Product; (c) the Business Customer shall take on the obligations in the WEEE Regulations for the sound environmental management of WEEE and hence the Business Customer shall be responsible for such information recording or reporting obligations imposed by Article 23 of the WEEE Regulations; (d) the Business Customer shall ensure that the WEEE is treated in accordance with the requirements of Article 21 of the WEEE Regulations; and (e) the Customer will become responsible for achieving the recovery and recycling targets stipulated in Article 22 of the WEEE Regulations.
